**ROAD TRAFFIC ACT  
(CHAPTER 276)**

**ROAD TRAFFIC (QUOTA SYSTEM — EXEMPTION)  
(AMENDMENT) ORDER 2015**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 142 of the Road Traffic Act, the Minister for Transport makes the following Order:

**Citation and commencement**

**1.** This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (Quota System — Exemption) (Amendment) Order 2015 and comes into operation on 6 November 2015.

**Amendment of paragraph 2**

**2.** Paragraph 2 of the Road Traffic (Quota System — Exemption) Order (O 5) is amended —

(a) by inserting, immediately before the definition of “consular employee”, the following definitions:

““bus services contractor” means any person who has a contract with the Authority to provide 10 or more regular route services specified in the contract;

“community bus service” means a bus service —

(a) consisting of the carriage of passengers by a bus for or in connection with the activities of a religious, educational, health, welfare, philanthropic, sporting or charitable organisation; and

(b) provided for a fare, or for consideration which is limited to the costs or part of the costs incurred in making the journey;”;
