**CRIMINAL PROCEDURE CODE (ELECTRONIC FILING  
AND SERVICE FOR SUPREME COURT)  
(AMENDMENT NO. 2) REGULATIONS 2014**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 428(2)(*da*) of the Criminal Procedure Code, the Minister for Law hereby makes the following Regulations:

**Citation and commencement**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Criminal Procedure Code (Electronic Filing and Service for Supreme Court) (Amendment No. 2) Regulations 2014 and shall come into operation on 1 January 2015.

**Amendment of regulation 4**

2. Regulation 4 of the Criminal Procedure Code (Electronic Filing and Service for Supreme Court) Regulations 2012 (G.N. No. S 669/2012) (referred to in these Regulations as the principal Regulations) is amended —

- (a) by inserting, immediately after the words “paragraph (1)” in paragraph (2), the words “for the Supreme Court (other than the Family Division of the High Court)”; and
- (b) by inserting, immediately after paragraph (2), the following paragraph:

“(3) The electronic filing service established under rule 914 of the Family Justice Rules 2014 (G.N. No. S 813/2014) shall be deemed to be the electronic filing service established under paragraph (1) for the Family Division of the High Court.”.
