**CRIMINAL PROCEDURE CODE
(ELECTRONIC FILING AND SERVICE)
(AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2014**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 428(2)(*da*) of the Criminal Procedure Code, the Minister for Law hereby makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Criminal Procedure Code (Electronic Filing and Service) (Amendment) Regulations 2014 and shall come into operation on 1 October 2014.

Amendment of regulation 1

2. Regulation 1 of the Criminal Procedure Code (Electronic Filing and Service) Regulations 2012 (G.N. No. S 669/2012) is amended by inserting, immediately after the word “Service”, the words “for Supreme Court”.

Amendment of regulation 3

3. Regulation 3 of the Criminal Procedure Code (Electronic Filing and Service) Regulations 2012 is amended by deleting the definition of “Registrar” and substituting the following definition:

“ “Registrar” means —

- (a) the Registrar of the Supreme Court, in relation to any document which, under the Criminal Procedure Code, is required to be filed with, served on, delivered or otherwise conveyed to the Supreme Court (other than the Family Division of the High Court), the Registrar of the Supreme
