In exercise of the powers conferred by section 2 of the Fees Act, the Minister for Finance hereby makes the following Order:

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Fees (Police Services) Order 2014.

Fees

2.—(1) The following fees shall be payable to the Commander “A” Division in respect of each warrant of arrest issued by a court under section 120 of the Criminal Procedure Code (Cap. 68, 2012 Ed.) upon the application of a police officer:

- (a) an administrative fee of \$16 payable upon such application for work done in obtaining the warrant from the court, including data entry and screening of the person against whom the warrant is to be issued;
- (b) an enforcement fee of \$239 payable upon such application for work to be done in order to enforce the warrant;
- (c) where the anniversary of the date on which the warrant was issued by the court is before 1st July 2014 —
