**PROBATION OF OFFENDERS  
(AMENDMENT NO. 2) RULES 2014**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 13(1) of the Probation of Offenders Act, the Minister for Social and Family Development hereby makes the following Rules:

**Citation and commencement**

**1.**—(1) These Rules may be cited as the Probation of Offenders (Amendment No. 2) Rules 2014 and shall, with the exception of rule 2(a) and (b), come into operation on 1 October 2014.

(2) Rule 2(a) and (b) shall come into operation on 1 January 2015.

**Amendment of rule 3**

**2.** Rule 3 of the Probation of Offenders Rules (R 1) is amended —

(a) by deleting paragraph (a) and substituting the following paragraph:

“(a) a representative of the Chief Justice, who shall be the Presiding Judge of the State Courts unless any other representative is appointed by the Chief Justice;”;

(b) by deleting paragraph (c);

(c) by deleting paragraph (e) and substituting the following paragraph:

“(e) a judge of the Youth Court;” and

(d) by deleting the words “Juvenile Court” in paragraph (f) and substituting the words “Youth Court”.
