# DANGEROUS FIREWORKS (EXEMPTION) (NO. 6) NOTIFICATION 2013

## ARRANGEMENT OF PARAGRAPHS

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 9 of the Dangerous Fireworks Act, the Minister for Home Affairs hereby makes the following Notification:

## Citation

**1.** This Notification may be cited as the Dangerous Fireworks (Exemption) (No. 6) Notification 2013.

# **Exemption**

**2.** Section 3 of the Act shall not apply in respect of dangerous fireworks used in a fireworks display executed by Glorious (S) Pte Ltd (referred to in this Notification as the exempted person) for or on behalf of any person at the event specified in Part I of the Schedule in accordance with the conditions specified in Part II thereof.

# **Application**

**3.** The Dangerous Fireworks (Annual Exemption) Notification 2012 (G.N. No. S 125/2012) shall not apply to any fireworks display

executed by the exempted person for or on behalf of any person at the event specified in Part I of the Schedule.

## THE SCHEDULE

Paragraphs 2 and 3

## PART I

#### **EVENT**

1. Name of Event: Chingay Heartland 2013 @ Nanyang

2. Places: (a) Open space carpark next to Block 953 Jurong West Street 91; and

(b) Floats along Jurong West Street 91.

3. Date and Time: On 2nd March 2013 from 7 p.m. to 10 p.m.

## PART II

#### CONDITIONS

- 1. The fireworks display shall be limited to the following types of fireworks:
  - (a) firecrackers;
  - (b) gerbs; and
  - (c) fountains.
- 2. In the fireworks display, no fireworks shall be discharged unless they have been certified safe and approved by
  - (a) the competent authority of the country of origin or manufacture; and
  - (b) the manufacturer of the fireworks.
- 3. In the fireworks display, no fireworks shall be discharged where the period of recommended usage of the fireworks has expired.
- 4. Where the fireworks display is executed, the exempted person shall execute it in accordance with the instructions by the manufacturer and maintain a safety area as recommended by the manufacturer.
- 5.—(1) The exempted person shall maintain a safety area around the firing point of the fireworks display in accordance with this paragraph.
- (2) The maximum height of firing for the fireworks event is 5 metres.
- (3) The safety area for each firing point shall be a radius of the furthest point of effect produced by the fireworks plus an additional distance of 6 metres (measured horizontally from the firing point).
