**MISUSE OF DRUGS ACT  
(AMENDMENT OF FIRST AND THIRD SCHEDULES)  
ORDER 2013**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 59 of the Misuse of Drugs Act, the Minister for Home Affairs hereby makes the following Order:

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the Misuse of Drugs Act (Amendment of First and Third Schedules) Order 2013 and shall come into operation on 1st May 2013.

**Amendment of First Schedule**

2. Part I of the First Schedule to the Misuse of Drugs Act is amended —

- (a) by deleting the item “3, 4, 5-trimethoxy- $\alpha$ -methyphenethylamine.” and substituting the item “3, 4, 5-trimethoxy- $\alpha$ -methylphenethylamine.” in paragraph 1; and
- (b) by inserting, immediately below the item “Benzyl fentanyl.” in paragraph 7, the item “Beta-Hydroxy-3-Methyl Fentanyl.”.

**Amendment of Third Schedule**

3.—(1) Part I of the Third Schedule to the Misuse of Drugs Act is amended —

- (a) by inserting, immediately above the item “N-acetylanthranilic acid also known as N-Acetyl-*o*-aminobenzoic acid” in paragraph 1, the item “Acetic anhydride also known as Acetic oxide”;
