DANGEROUS FIREWORKS (EXEMPTION) (NO. 5) NOTIFICATION 2012

ARRANGEMENT OF PARAGRAPHS

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 9 of the Dangerous Fireworks Act, the Minister for Home Affairs hereby makes the following Notification:

Citation

1. This Notification may be cited as the Dangerous Fireworks (Exemption) (No. 5) Notification 2012.

Exemption

2. Section 3 of the Act shall not apply in respect of dangerous fireworks used in a fireworks display executed by Glorious (S) Pte Ltd (referred to in this Notification as the exempted person) for or on behalf of any person at the event specified in Part I of the Schedule in accordance with the conditions specified in Part II thereof.

Application

3. The Dangerous Fireworks (Annual Exemption) Notification 2012 (G.N. No. S 125/2012) shall not apply to any fireworks display executed by the exempted person for or on behalf of any person at the event specified in Part I of the Schedule.

PART I

EVENT

- 1. Name of Event: Singapore Grand Prix F1 Night Race 2012.
- 2. Places:
- (a) Kallang Basin, Marina Channel;
- (b) Opposite Esplanade Jetty, Marina Bay;
- (c) Padang open field next to Singapore Recreational Club;
- (d) Top of lighting truss, F1 Race Track; and
- (e) Podium, F1 Pit Building.
- 3. Dates and Times: 21st September 2012 between 6 p.m. and 11.30 p.m. 23rd September 2012 between 6 p.m. and 11.30 p.m.

PART II

CONDITIONS

- 1. The fireworks display shall be limited to the following types of fireworks:
 - (a) coloured stars;
 - (b) airbursts;
 - (c) gerbs;
 - (d) concussions;
 - (e) fountains;
 - (f) theatrical flashes;
 - (g) falls;
 - (h) mines;
 - (i) multiple shots;
 - (j) comets;
 - (k) shells;
 - (l) roman candles; and
 - (m) electric igniters.
- 2. In the fireworks display, no fireworks shall be discharged unless they have been certified safe and approved by
 - (a) the competent authority of the country of origin or manufacture; and
 - (b) the manufacturer of the fireworks.
- 3. In the fireworks display, no fireworks shall be discharged where the period of recommended usage of the fireworks has expired.
