ARRANGEMENT OF PARAGRAPHS

Paragraph

1. Citation and commencement
2. Remission of visa fee

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 46(2) of the Interpretation Act, the Minister for Home Affairs hereby makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Interpretation (Remission of Singapore Visa Fees) (ICPO-INTERPOL) Order 2012 and shall come into operation on 3rd September 2012.

Remission of visa fee

2.—(1) There shall be remitted all fees payable under paragraph 3 of the Interpretation (Singapore Visa — Fees) Order 2007 (G.N. No. S 652/2007) by the following persons for their travel to and entry into Singapore for the purposes of their functions with or missions to the Complex:

- (a) delegates from foreign sovereign Powers which are members of the ICPO-INTERPOL, and observers attending conferences or meetings convened by the ICPO-INTERPOL;
- (b) members of the Executive Committee of the ICPO-INTERPOL;
