(SPECIAL AND SENIOR PERSONNEL BOARDS)
(AMENDMENT NO. 3) ORDER 2012**

In exercise of the powers conferred by Article 110D(1) and (2) of the Constitution of the Republic of Singapore, the President, on the advice of Deputy Prime Minister Teo Chee Hean, charged with the responsibility for the portfolio of the Prime Minister, hereby makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Public Service (Special and Senior Personnel Boards) (Amendment No. 3) Order 2012 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1st October 2012.
