ARRANGEMENT OF PARAGRAPHS

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 9 of the Dangerous Fireworks Act, the Minister for Home Affairs hereby makes the following Notification:

Citation

1. This Notification may be cited as the Dangerous Fireworks (Exemption) (No. 10) Notification 2011.

Exemption

2. Section 3 of the Act shall not apply in respect of dangerous fireworks used in a fireworks display executed by Glorious (S) Pte Ltd (referred to in this Notification as the exempted person) for or on behalf of any person at the event specified in Part I of the Schedule in accordance with the conditions specified in Part II thereof.

Application

3. The Dangerous Fireworks (Exemption) (No. 7) Notification 2011 (G.N. No. S 158/2011) shall not apply to any fireworks display executed by the exempted person for or on behalf of any person at the event specified in Part I of the Schedule.

THE SCHEDULE

Paragraphs 2 and 3

PART I

EVENT

1. Name of Event: Grand Prix F1 Night Race
2. Places:
 - (a) Kallang Basin, Marina Channel;
 - (b) Road opposite Corporate Suite, Republic Boulevard;
 - (c) Padang Field, Republic Boulevard; and
 - (d) Floating Platform, Republic Boulevard.
3. Dates and Times: 23rd September 2011 between 6 p.m. and 1 a.m. of the following day
24th September 2011 between 6 p.m. and 1 a.m. of the following day
25th September 2011 between 6 p.m. and 1 a.m. of the following day.

PART II

CONDITIONS

1. The fireworks display shall be limited to the following types of fireworks:
 - (a) shells;
 - (b) quick match;
 - (c) theatrical flashes;
 - (d) fountains;
 - (e) concussions;
 - (f) gerbs;
 - (g) comets;
 - (h) mines;
 - (i) multiple shots;
 - (j) roman candles;
 - (k) electric igniters;
 - (l) lances; and
 - (m) coloured stars.
2. In the fireworks display, no fireworks shall be discharged unless they have been certified safe and approved by —
 - (a) the competent authority of the country of origin or manufacture; and
 - (b) the manufacturer of the fireworks.
