**ROAD TRAFFIC ACT  
(CHAPTER 276)**

**ROAD TRAFFIC  
(DRIVER IMPROVEMENT POINTS SYSTEM)  
(AMENDMENT NO. 2) RULES 2011**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 45(2) of the Road Traffic Act, the Minister for Home Affairs hereby makes the following Rules:

**Citation and commencement**

**1.** These Rules may be cited as the Road Traffic (Driver Improvement Points System) (Amendment No. 2) Rules 2011 and shall come into operation on 1st January 2012.

**Amendment of Schedule**

**2.** The Schedule to the Road Traffic (Driver Improvement Points System) Rules (R 25) is amended —

(a) by deleting item (16) and substituting the following item:

“(16) Driver failing to wear seat belt [Rule 4(1), 3”]; and  
Road Traffic (Motor Vehicles, Wearing of  
Seat Belts) Rules 2011 (G.N. No. S 688/2011)]

(b) by deleting items (35) to (38) and substituting the following items:

“(35) Driver failing to ensure that every passenger 3  
wears a seat belt [Rule 5, Road Traffic (Motor  
Vehicles, Wearing of Seat Belts) Rules 2011]

(36) Using a motor vehicle where a person below 3”.  
1.35 metres in height is a passenger and is not  
properly secured by an approved child restraint  
or a body-restraining seat belt [Rule 8(1), Road  
Traffic (Motor Vehicles, Wearing of Seat Belts)  
Rules 2011]
