**WORKPLACE SAFETY AND HEALTH ACT
(CHAPTER 354A)**

**WORKPLACE SAFETY AND HEALTH (FIRST-AID)
(AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2011**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 65 of the Workplace Safety and Health Act, the Minister for Manpower hereby makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Workplace Safety and Health (First-Aid) (Amendment) Regulations 2011 and shall come into operation on 10th September 2011.

Deletion and substitution of regulations 2 and 3

2. Regulations 2 and 3 of the Workplace Safety and Health (First-Aid) Regulations (Rg 4) (referred to in these Regulations as the principal Regulations) are deleted and the following regulations substituted therefor:

“Definitions

2. In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires —

“dentist” means a registered dentist under the Dental Registration Act (Cap. 76) who has in force a practising certificate issued under that Act;

“first-aid” means —

- (a) in cases where a person needs help from a medical practitioner or nurse, treatment for the purpose of preserving life and minimising the consequences of bodily injury until such help is obtained; or
- (b) treatment of minor bodily injury which does not require treatment by a medical practitioner or nurse;
