**COMPULSORY EDUCATION ACT  
(CHAPTER 51)**

**COMPULSORY EDUCATION  
(EXEMPTION) (AMENDMENT)  
ORDER 2010**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 4(1) of the Compulsory Education Act, the Minister for Education hereby makes the following Order:

**Citation and commencement**

**1.** This Order may be cited as the Compulsory Education (Exemption) (Amendment) Order 2010 and shall come into operation on 1st October 2010.

**Amendment of paragraph 2**

**2.** Paragraph 2 of the Compulsory Education (Exemption) Order (O 1) is amended by inserting, immediately after the definition of “home-schooling”, the following definition:

“ “home visit” means a visit conducted by the Director-General, to any place where the child receives or will receive home-schooling (as the case may be), for the purposes of inspecting and assessing the home-schooling arrangements;”.

**Amendment of paragraph 3**

**3.** Paragraph 3 of the Compulsory Education (Exemption) Order is amended —

(a) by deleting sub-paragraph (b) and substituting the following sub-paragraph:

“(b) any child who receives home-schooling, subject to the following terms and conditions:

(i) a parent of the child has notified the Director-General, in such form and manner as the Director-General may require, of the
