**Responsibility of Minister for Information, Communications and the Arts**

It is hereby notified for general information that, pursuant to Article 30(1) of the Constitution of the Republic of Singapore, the Prime Minister has directed that RAdm (NS) Lui Tuck Yew shall, with effect from 1st November 2010, be charged with the responsibility for the departments and subjects set out in the Schedule and that he shall be designated as the Minister for Information, Communications and the Arts.
