**ENDANGERED SPECIES (IMPORT AND EXPORT) ACT (AMENDMENT OF
SCHEDULE) (NO. 2) NOTIFICATION 2010**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 28 of the Endangered Species (Import and Export) Act, the Minister for National Development hereby makes the following Notification:

Citation and commencement

1. This Notification may be cited as the Endangered Species (Import and Export) Act (Amendment of Schedule) (No. 2) Notification 2010 and shall come into operation on 14th October 2010.

Amendment of Schedule

2. The Appendices of the Schedule to the Endangered Species (Import and Export) Act are amended —

- (a) by inserting, immediately after “14.78” in paragraph (h) of footnote 5 relating to item 3 in taxon XV relating to “PROBOSCIDEA”, the words “(Rev. CoP15)”;

- (b) by deleting sub-heading A and the items thereunder in taxon II relating to “LEPIDOPTERA” and substituting the following sub-headings and items:
