ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC SIGNS) (EXEMPTION) ORDER 2010

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 142 of the Road Traffic Act, the Minister for Transport hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (Traffic Signs) (Exemption) Order 2010.

Definitions

- 2. In this Order
 - "bus lane" means a part-day bus lane or full-day bus lane as described in rule 7(11) and (11A), respectively, of the Road Traffic (Traffic Signs) Rules (R 33);
 - "specified bus" means any bus designated as an official vehicle for use in connection with the Youth Olympic Games 2010 and which is identifiable from its markings, livery, blinker lights and licence plates as illustrated in Illustrations 1, 2, 3 and 8 of the Third Schedule to the Road Traffic (Youth
