ADMINISTRATION OF MUSLIM LAW (HALAL CERTIFICATES) (AMENDMENT) RULES 2009

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 88E(3) of the Administration of Muslim Law Act, the Majlis Ugama Islam, Singapura, with the approval of the Minister for the Environment and Water Resources, charged with the responsibility for the portfolio of the Minister for Community Development, Youth and Sports (G.N. No. S 323/2006), hereby makes the following Rules:

Citation and commencement

1. These Rules may be cited as the Administration of Muslim Law (Halal Certificates) (Amendment) Rules 2009 and shall come into operation on 1st March 2009.

Deletion and substitution of rule 6

2. Rule 6 of the Administration of Muslim Law (Halal Certificates) Rules (R 8) is deleted and the following rule substituted therefor:

“Compoundable offence

6. An offence under section 88A(5) of the Act may be compounded by the Majlis in accordance with section 88E of the Act.”.
