**MARITIME AND PORT AUTHORITY OF SINGAPORE (SCALE OF DUES, RATES
AND GENERAL FEES) (AMENDMENT NO. 2) NOTIFICATION 2007**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 27 (1), (7) and (8) of the Maritime and Port Authority of Singapore Act, the Maritime and Port Authority of Singapore, with the approval of the Minister for Transport, hereby makes the following Notification:

Citation and commencement

1. This Notification may be cited as the Maritime and Port Authority of Singapore (Scale of Dues, Rates and General Fees) (Amendment No. 2) Notification 2007 and shall come into operation on 1st October 2007.

Amendment of Schedule

2. The Schedule to the Maritime and Port Authority of Singapore (Scale of Dues, Rates and General Fees) Notification (N 2) is amended —

- (a) by deleting paragraph 9 (including the sub-heading) of Part II and substituting the following paragraph:

CHARGES FOR FIRE-FIGHTING, OIL SPILL RESPONSE AND ANTI-POLLUTION SERVICES

9.—(1) The charges for fire-fighting, oil spill response and anti-pollution services provided by the Authority to save life or property are as follows:

	<i>Rate per hour or part thereof from the time the vessel leaves the base to the time it returns to base and is no longer required</i>	<i>Rate per day for usage of services exceeding 8 hours in a day</i>	<i>Standby rate per day or part thereof, for the period that the vessel is on standby at a forward storage area or base or in transit</i>

(b) for the deployment of an anti-pollution vessel as follows:
