IMMIGRATION ACT (CHAPTER 133)

IMMIGRATION (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2006

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 55(1) of the Immigration Act, the Minister for Home Affairs hereby makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Immigration (Amendment) Regulations 2006 and shall come into operation on 16th January 2006.

Amendment of regulation 14

2. Regulation 14 of the Immigration Regulations (Rg 1) is amended by deleting paragraph (1A) and substituting the following paragraph:

“(1A) Every student’s pass issued under paragraph (1) shall be subject to the condition that the holder shall not engage in any form of paid employment or in any business, profession or occupation in Singapore during the validity of that pass unless —

- (a) he is on vacation, is 14 years of age or above and is a full-time matriculated or registered student of any recognised university or education institution set out in Part I of the Second Schedule;
- (b) he is not required to work for more than 16 hours a week and is a full-time matriculated or registered student of any recognised university or education institution set out in Part II of the Second Schedule; or
- (c) he has the consent in writing of the Controller.”.

Amendment of First Schedule

- 3. The First Schedule to the Immigration Regulations is amended —**
(a) by deleting Form 17A and substituting the following Form:

IMPORTANT NOTICE

1. This Pass is issued subject to the condition that the holder thereof shall not —
 - (a) be engaged in any form of employment or in any business, profession or occupation in Singapore whether paid or unpaid, unless he falls within the exemption set out in regulation 14 (1A) of the Immigration Regulations (Cap. 133, Rg 1);
 - (b) be proposed for adoption in any adoption proceedings commenced in Singapore;
 - (c) be involved in any criminal or drug offences in Singapore; and
 - (d) enter or be retained as a student in any other school/institution other than that specified overleaf.
2. This Pass shall cease to be valid if the holder thereof fails to enter or to be retained as a student in the school/institution specified overleaf.
3. This Pass has to be produced for every extension.
