Variation of Responsibility of Minister for Law

It is hereby notified for general information that, pursuant to Article 30(1) of the Constitution of the Republic of Singapore, the Prime Minister has varied, with effect from 1st April 2005, the Schedule to the Constitution of the Republic of Singapore (Responsibility of the Minister for Law) Notification 2004 (G.N. No. S 537/2004) by deleting the words “Strata Titles Boards.” under the heading “*Departments/Statutory Bodies*”.
