FEEDING STUFFS (COMPOSITION OF OFFENCES) RULES 2005

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 11 of the Feeding Stuffs Act, read with section 199A of the Criminal Procedure Code (Cap. 68), the Minister for National Development hereby makes the following Rules:

Citation and commencement

1. These Rules may be cited as the Feeding Stuffs (Composition of Offences) Rules 2005 and shall come into operation on 1st April 2005.

Compoundable offences

- **2.**—(1) The following offences may be compounded by the Director-General, or any officer authorised by him, in accordance with section 199A of the Criminal Procedure Code:
 - (a) an offence under section 4 (5) or 10 of the Act; and
 - (b) any offence under the Feeding Stuffs (Licensing, Analysis and Fees) Rules (R 1).
