DANGEROUS FIREWORKS ACT (CHAPTER 72)

DANGEROUS FIREWORKS (EXEMPTION) (NO. 3) NOTIFICATION 2003

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 9 of the Dangerous Fireworks Act, the Minister for Home Affairs hereby makes the following Notification:

Citation

1. This Notification may be cited as the Dangerous Fireworks (Exemption) (No. 3) Notification 2003.

Exemption

2. Section 3 of the Act shall not apply in respect of dangerous fireworks used in a

fireworks display executed by Explomo Technical Services Pte Ltd (referred to in this Notification as the exempted person) for or on behalf of any person at —

- (a) the National Day Parade 2003 Sample Firing Test on the place, date and time specified in Part I of the First Schedule in accordance with the conditions specified in Part II thereof;
- (b) the Singapore National Day Parade 2003 Celebrations on the place, date and time specified in Part I of the Second Schedule in accordance with the conditions specified in Part II thereof;
- (c) the Singapore National Day Parade 2003 Celebrations on the place, date and time specified in Part I of the Third Schedule in accordance with the conditions specified in Part II thereof; and
- (d) the Singapore National Day Parade 2003 Celebrations on the place, date and time specified in Part I of the Fourth Schedule in accordance with the conditions specified in Part II thereof.

PART II

CONDITIONS

1. The fireworks display shall be limited to fireworks of the following types:
 - (a) White Smoke;
 - (b) Silver Jets;
 - (c) Roman Candle Mix Colour Bombete;

- (d) Mix Colour Bombete;
- (e) Electric Silver Reports; and
- (f) Shells.

2. No fireworks shall be discharged in the fireworks display unless the fireworks have been certified safe and approved —

- (a) by the competent authority of the country of origin of manufacture; and
- (b) by the manufacturer of the said fireworks.

3. No fireworks shall be discharged in the fireworks display where the period of recommended usage of the fireworks has expired.

4.—(1) The exempted person shall maintain a safety area around the firing point of the fireworks display in accordance with this paragraph.

(2) The maximum height of firing is 340 metres and the safety area shall have a radius of not less than 160 metres, measured horizontally from the firing point.

(3) The exempted person shall remove all combustible materials within the safety area to prevent ignition during the display.

(4) The exempted person shall cordon off and control access to such area.

5. The exempted person shall ensure that —

- (a) adequate and appropriate first-aid equipment is readily available at hand throughout the duration of the fireworks display;
- (b) appropriate and sufficient fire extinguishers as required by the Commissioner, Singapore Civil Defence Force, are readily available at hand throughout the duration of the fireworks display; and
- (c) all additional safety measures required in writing by the Officer-in-Charge, Arms and Explosives Branch of the Singapore Police Force and by the Commissioner, Singapore Civil Defence Force, are complied with.

CONDITIONS

1. The fireworks display shall be limited to White Smoke.
2. No fireworks shall be discharged in the fireworks display unless they have been certified safe and approved —
 - (a) by the competent authority of the country of origin of manufacture; and
 - (b) by the manufacturer of the said fireworks.
3. No fireworks shall be discharged in the fireworks display where the period of recommended usage of the fireworks has expired.
- 4.—(1) The exempted person shall maintain a safety area around the firing point of the fireworks display in accordance with this paragraph.
 - (2) The maximum height of firing is 180 metres and the safety area shall have a radius of not less than 160 metres, measured horizontally from the firing point.
 - (3) The exempted person shall remove all combustible materials within the safety area to prevent ignition during the display.
 - (4) The exempted person shall cordon off and control access to such area.
5. The exempted person shall ensure that —
 - (a) adequate and appropriate first-aid equipment is readily available at hand throughout the duration of the fireworks display;
 - (b) appropriate and sufficient fire extinguishers as required by the Commissioner, Singapore Civil Defence Force, are readily available at hand throughout the duration of the fireworks display; and
 - (c) all additional safety measures required in writing by the Officer-in-Charge, Arms and Explosives Branch of the Singapore Police Force and by the Commissioner, Singapore Civil Defence Force, are complied with.
