DANGEROUS FIREWORKS ACT (CHAPTER 72)

DANGEROUS FIREWORKS (EXEMPTION) NOTIFICATION 2003

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 9 of the Dangerous Fireworks Act, the Minister for Home Affairs hereby makes the following Notification:

Citation

1. This Notification may be cited as the Dangerous Fireworks (Exemption) Notification 2003.

Exemption

2. Section 3 of the Act shall not apply in respect of dangerous fireworks used in a fireworks display executed by Explomo Technical Services Pte Ltd (referred to in this Notification as the exempted person) for or on behalf of any person at —

- (a) the event specified in Part I of the First Schedule in accordance with the conditions specified in Part II thereof; and

- (b) the event specified in Part I of the Second Schedule in accordance with the conditions specified in Part II thereof.

PART II

CONDITIONS

1. The fireworks display shall be limited to fireworks of the following types:
 - (a) Assorted shells; and
 - (b) Roman candles.
2. No fireworks shall be discharged in the fireworks display unless they have been certified safe and approved —
 - (a) by the competent authority of the country of origin of manufacture; and
 - (b) by the manufacturer of the said fireworks.
3. No fireworks shall be discharged in the fireworks display where the period of recommended usage of the fireworks has expired.
- 4.—(1) The exempted person shall maintain a safety area around the firing point of the fireworks display in accordance with this paragraph.
 - (2) The maximum height of firing is 180 metres and the safety area shall have a radius of not less than 180 metres, measured horizontally from the firing point.
 - (3) The exempted person shall remove all combustible materials within the safety area to prevent ignition during the display.
