1. These Regulations may be cited as the Intoxicating Substances (Discipline in Approved Centres) (Amendment) Regulations 2003.

Amendment of regulation 2

- **2.** Regulation 2 of the Intoxicating Substances (Discipline in Approved Centres) Regulations (Rg 2) is amended by deleting the definition of "medical officer" and substituting the following definition:
 - ""medical officer" means a registered medical practitioner who is for the time being appointed by the Director of Prisons to perform the functions of a medical officer under these Regulations;".
