DANGEROUS FIREWORKS (EXEMPTION) (NO. 5) NOTIFICATION 2002

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 9 of the Dangerous Fireworks Act, the Minister for Home Affairs hereby makes the following Notification:

Citation

1. This Notification may be cited as the Dangerous Fireworks (Exemption) (No. 5) Notification 2002.

Exemption

- **2.** Section 3 of the Act shall not apply in respect of dangerous fireworks used in a fireworks display executed by Explomo Technical Services Pte Ltd (referred to in this Notification as the exempted person) for or on behalf of any person at
 - (a) the event specified in Part I of the First Schedule in accordance with the conditions specified in Part II thereof; and

(b) the event specified in Part I of the Second Schedule in accordance with the conditions specified in Part II thereof.

PART I

EVENT

1. Name of event: Official Opening of the Esplanade

2. Place: Roof claddings of Esplanade

3. Date and time: 12th October 2002 7.30 p.m. to 8.15 p.m.

PART II

CONDITIONS

- 1. The fireworks display shall be limited to silver jets.
- 2. No fireworks shall be discharged in the fireworks display unless they have been certified safe and approved
 - (a) by the competent authority of the country of origin of manufacture; and
 - (b) by the manufacturer of the said fireworks.
- 3. No fireworks shall be discharged in the fireworks display where the period of recommended usage of the fireworks has expired.
- 4.—(1) The exempted person shall maintain a safety area around the firing point of the fireworks display in accordance with this paragraph.
- (2) The maximum height of firing is 5 metres and the safety area shall have a radius of not less than 3 metres, measured horizontally from the firing point.
- (3) The exempted person shall remove all combustible materials within the safety area to prevent ignition during the display.
 - (4) The exempted person shall cordon off and control access to such area.
 - 5. The exempted person shall ensure that
 - (a) adequate and appropriate first-aid equipment is readily available at hand throughout the duration of the fireworks display;
 - (b) appropriate and sufficient fire extinguishers as required by the Commissioner, Singapore Civil Defence Force, are readily available at hand throughout the duration of the fireworks
