PATENTS ACT (CHAPTER 221)

PATENTS (EXCLUDED DAY) RULES 2002

In exercise of the powers conferred by sections 111 and 115 of the Patents Act, the Minister for Law, after consultation with the Intellectual Property Office of Singapore, hereby makes the following Rules:

Citation

1. These Rules may be cited as the Patents (Excluded Day) Rules 2002.

Excluded day

2. In addition to the excluded days set out in rule 99 of the Patents Rules (R 1), 11th February 2002 shall be an excluded day for all purposes under the Act and the Patents Rules except for —

- (a) any inspection of the register of patents under section 42 of the Act;
- (b) the filing of any application for a patent, not being an application in or in connection with which a declaration for priority referred to in section 17(2) of the Act is made; and
