# INTERPRETATION ACT (CHAPTER 1)

# DELEGATION OF POWERS (MINISTRY OF LAW) NOTIFICATION 2000

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 36(1) of the Interpretation Act, the Minister for Law hereby makes the following Notification:

### **Citation and commencement**

**1.** This Notification may be cited as the Delegation of Powers (Ministry of Law) Notification 2000 and shall come into operation on 11th December 2000.

### **Delegation of powers**

2. The Minister for Law, with the approval of the President, hereby deputes the persons set out in the first column of the Schedule to exercise the powers of the Minister set out in the second column thereof.

# **3.** The Delegation of Powers (Ministry of Law) (Consolidation) Notification (N 10, 2000 Ed.) is cancelled.
