## **PRESERVATION OF MONUMENTS ACT (CHAPTER 239)**

### **PRESERVATION OF MONUMENTS (NO. 3) ORDER 1998**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 8(1) of the Preservation of Monuments Act, the Minister for Information and the Arts, on the advice of the Preservation of Monuments Board, hereby makes the following Order:

#### **Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the Preservation of Monuments (No. 3) Order 1998 and shall come into operation on 18th December 1998.

#### **Monument**

2. The monument specified in the Schedule is hereby placed under the protection of the Preservation of Monuments Board.

### **THE SCHEDULE**

1. The building known as the Central Fire Station erected on the land known as lots 135 and 463 TS

20 at Hill Street, Singapore being within the boundary described as follows:

Commencing at the northern-most corner at the point of 30,531.38 metres North and 29,770.65 metres East of the Survey Department origin of co-ordinates and continuing along the successive lines of bearings and distances set out below:
