PRESERVATION OF MONUMENTS (NO. 4) ORDER 1998

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 8(1) of the Preservation of Monuments Act, the Minister for Information and the Arts, on the advice of the Preservation of Monuments Board, hereby makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Preservation of Monuments (No. 4) Order 1998 and shall come into operation on 18th December 1998.

Monuments

2. The monuments specified in the Schedule are hereby placed under the protection of the Preservation of Monuments Board.

THE SCHEDULE

1. The building known as the Old Nanyang University Library and Administration Building erected

on the land known as lot 531 pt MK 9 at Nanyang Drive, Singapore being within the boundary described as follows:

Commencing at the northern-most corner at the point of 36,258.64 metres North and 11,421.26 metres East of the Survey Department origin of co-ordinates and continuing along the successive lines of bearings and distances set out below:
