IMMIGRATION (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 1997

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 55(1) of the Immigration Act, the Minister for Home Affairs hereby makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Immigration (Amendment) Regulations 1997 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 17th February 1997.

Amendment of First Schedule

2. The First Schedule to the Immigration Regulations (Rg 1) is amended by deleting Forms 15A and 17A and substituting the following Forms:

IMPORTANT NOTICE

1. As the holder of this card, you shall abide by the conditions specified in regulations 12(7), (9) and (10) and 19(3), (4) and (5) of the Immigration Regulations made under the Immigration Act (Cap. 133).
2. You are required to produce this card when demanded by any immigration officer, police officer or other authorised officer and to report to the Controller any change in your address in Singapore within 14 days of such change.
3. You are required to produce this card together with your passport or travel document to the immigration officer at the checkpoint each time you leave or return to Singapore.
4. Should you intend to leave Singapore and return only after the expiry of this card, please surrender this card to the immigration officer at the checkpoint at the time of your departure.
5. This card shall cease to be valid on the expiry date stated overleaf or when you cease to hold a valid passport/travel document, whichever is earlier.
