TAXI FARES UNDER THE SHARE-A-CAB SCHEME

It is hereby notified for general information that, pursuant to section 20(1) of the Public Transport Council Act, the Public Transport Council has approved, with effect from 1st June 1997, the maximum rates of hire of a taxi under the Share-A-Cab Scheme, whereby passengers alight at different set-down points, as set out in the Schedule.

THE SCHEDULE

1. Where alighting passengers pay at each set-down point, the rate of hire shall, subject to paragraphs 2 and 3, be a fixed percentage of the total fare applicable at the respective set-down points as follows:

No of set-down points	Percentage of total fare payable at each respective set-down point
2	70%
3	60%
4	50%

- 2. The total fare payable shall include the metered fare and any applicable surcharges set out in *Gazette* Notification No. S 269/97 relating to taxi fares.
 - 3. The distance between any 2 set-down points shall not exceed 8 kilometres.
 - 4. Where a single taxi fare is paid at the last set-down point, the fare payable shall be the total fare
