CONSUMER PROTECTION (TRADE DESCRIPTIONS AND SAFETY REQUIREMENTS) ACT (CHAPTER 53)

APPOINTMENT OF DIRECTOR, DEPUTY DIRECTOR AND ASSISTANT DIRECTORS OF CONSUMER PROTECTION

It is hereby notified for general information that, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 3(1) of the Consumer Protection (Trade Descriptions and Safety Requirements) Act, the Minister for Trade and Industry has, with effect from 1st April 1996, appointed —

- (a) the Director, Ministry of Trade and Industry, in charge of domestic trade matters, to be the Director of Consumer Protection;
- (b) the Deputy Director, Ministry of Trade and Industry, in charge of domestic trade matters, to be the Deputy Director of Consumer Protection;
- (c) the Assistant Directors, Ministry of Trade and Industry, in charge of domestic trade matters, the Director and the Chief Pharmacist of the Pharmaceutical Department, Ministry of Health and the Divisional Director and the Deputy Divisional Director, Standards Division, Singapore Productivity and Standards Board, to be the Assistant Directors of Consumer Protection;
- (d) the Economic Officers, Ministry of Trade and Industry, in charge of domestic trade matters, to be officers of Consumer Protection;
