1. These Regulations may be cited as the Private Hospitals and Medical Clinics (Composition of Offences) Regulations.

Compoundable offences

- **2.** The following offences may be compounded by the Director in accordance with section 20(1) of the Act:
 - (a) any offence under section 5, 7, 12 or 14(1) or (2) of the Act; and
 - (b) any offence under regulation 60 of the Private Hospitals and Medical Clinics Regulations (Rg 1) in connection with any contravention or failure
