TRADITIONAL CHINESE MEDICINE PRACTITIONERS (REGISTER AND PRACTISING CERTIFICATES) REGULATIONS

Citation

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Traditional Chinese Medicine Practitioners (Register and Practising Certificates) Regulations.

Copy of entry in Register

2. The Registrar may, upon an application by any person accompanied by the fee specified in the Schedule, provide a certified copy of an entry in the Register to the person.

Registration of additional qualification

3.—(1) A registered person who obtains a qualification in addition to the qualification by virtue of which he has been registered may apply to the Registrar to have that additional qualification entered in the Register.

(2) An application referred to in paragraph (1) shall be accompanied by the fee specified in the Schedule.

(3) The Board shall determine what additional qualification may be entered in the Register.

Practising certificate

4.—(1) An application for a practising certificate under section 17 of the Act shall be in such form as the Board may provide, and shall be accompanied by the fee specified in the Schedule.

(2) A practising certificate shall be granted for a period not exceeding 2 years from the date of issue of the practising certificate.

Renewal of practising certificate

5.—(1) An application for renewal of a practising certificate shall be in such form as the Board may provide, and shall be accompanied by the fee specified in the Schedule.

(2) Where an application for the renewal of a practising certificate is submitted later
