1. This Order may be cited as the International Organisations (Immunities and Privileges) (Food and Agriculture Organisation) Order.

A. THE ORGANISATION

2. The Food and Agriculture Organisation (referred to in this Order as the Organisation) is an organisation of which the Government of the Republic of Singapore and the governments of foreign sovereign Powers are members.

3. The Organisation shall have the legal capacities of a body corporate and, except in so far as in any particular case it has expressly waived its immunity, immunity from suit and legal process. No waiver of immunity shall be deemed to extend to any measure of execution.
