Interpretation

1. In this Act, unless the context indicates otherwise, a word or expression to which a meaning has been assigned in the Public Finance Management Act, 1999 (Act No. 1 5 of 1999), has the meaning assigned to it in that Act.

Approval of unauthorised expenditure

(a) The unauthorised expenditure referred to in Schedule 1 in the amount of R40 292 419.92, and described in the report of the National Assembly's Committee on Public Accounts identified in the second column of the Schedule, is authorised as an 10 additional charge against the National Revenue Fund in terms of section 34(1)(a) of the Public Finance Management Act, 1999 (Act No. 1 of 1999).
