FILMS AND PUBLICATIONS ACT 65 OF 1996

REGULATIONS ON THE ADVISORY PANEL AND NOMINATION OF CANDIDATES FOR COUNCIL AND APPEAL TRIBUNAL

The Minister of Home Affairs, has under section 31(1)(b) of the Films and Publications Act, 1996 (Act No. 65 of 1996) made the regulations in the Schedule.

Definitions

- In these Regulations, any word or expression to which a meaning has been assigned in the Act shall have the meaning so assigned, and unless the context otherwise indicates —
- "advisory panel" means the panel referred to in section 6(2) and (3) of the Act;
- "Director-General" means the Director-General of the Department of Home Affairs:
- "Secretariat" means the staff designated to provide secretarial services to the advisory panel; and
- "the Act" means the Films and Publications Act, 1996 (Act No. 65 of 1996).

Advisory panel

2. Members of the advisory panel contemplated in section 6(2) and (3) of the Act shall have experience in, or knowledge of, the matters referred to in section 6(4)(b) of the Act.

Nomination of candidates for appointment to council and appeal tribunal

- **3.** (1) The Chairperson of the advisory panel shall, within seven days after the appointment of members to the advisory panel, invite the public to nominate candidates for appointment as members of the Council and Appeal Tribunal.
- (2) The invitation contemplated in subregulation (1) shall be extended to the whole of the Republic in the manner and within the period the Minister considers fit.

Manner and time to make nominations

- **4.** (1) Nominations must be submitted to the secretariat within 21 days after the date of the last publication of the invitation for public nominations.
- (2) Nominations shall be submitted in writing and shall include—
 - (a) the full name and contact details of the person being nominated,
 - (b) a brief curriculum vitae of the person being nominated, and
