## PRIVATE SECURITY INDUSTRY REGULATION ACT, 2001 (ACT NO. 56 OF 2001): EXEMPTION IN TERMS OF SECTIONS 1(2) AND 20(5) OF THE ACT

By virtue of the power vested in the Minister for Safety and Security by sections 1(2) and 20(5) of the Private Security Industry Regulation Act, 2001 (Act No. 56 of 2001), I, Emanuel Nkosinathi Mthethwa, hereby determine that Graeme Barnard and Henk Theron, are exempted from the provisions of sections 20(2)(a) and 20(2)(b) of the Private Security Industry Regulation Act, 2001 (Act No. 56 of 2001), to be appointed as directors of Rentrak (Pty) Ltd without the requirement to register as security service providers, on condition that -

- this exemption will lapse after a period of five years from the date of publication of this notice and for as long as they are directors of Rentrak (Pty) Ltd;
- they remain in the capacity of director supply chain human resources and chief financial officer respectively; and
- they may not be involved with the day-to-day security functions of the company or may not function as security service providers.
