NOTICE OF NOMINATIONS

NOMINATIONS OF MEMBERS OF THE <u>PROFESSIONAL BOARD FOR</u> EMERGENCY CARE PRACTITIONERS

- (1) Notice is hereby given in terms of the provisions of the Regulations relating to the nomination and appointment of members of a professional board, calling upon all persons registered with the <u>Professional board for Emergency Care Practitioners</u> to submit nominations of <u>sixteen (16)</u> members of such board to be appointed by the Minister to serve on the board for a period of five (5) years commencing on a date to be determined by the Minister by Notice in the Gazette.
- (2) Nominations are specifically invited in the following categories:-
 - (a) four (4) advanced life support emergency care practitioners, of whom at least two (2) shall be from designated groups and at least one (1) shall be a woman, who shall be nominated by persons with registered postal addresses in the Republic and whose names appear in the register of paramedics or any other register falling within the profession of advanced life support emergency care;
 - (b) two (2) intermediate life support emergency care practitioners, of whom at least one shall be a woman, who shall be nominated by persons with registered postal addresses in the Republic and whose names appear in the register of ambulance emergency assistants, operational emergency care orderlies or any other register falling within the profession of intermediate life support emergency care;
 - (c) two (2) basic life support emergency care practitioners, of whom at least one shall be from designated groups and at least one shall be a woman, who shall be nominated by persons with registered postal addresses in the Republic and whose names appear in the register of basic ambulance assistants, emergency care assistants or any other register falling within the profession of basic life support emergency care;
 - (d) four (4) emergency care practitioners, of whom at least two shall be from designated groups and at least one shall be a woman, who shall be nominated by persons with registered postal
