# BIRDS PRESERVATION ACT

## AN ACT TO MAKE PROVISION FOR THE PRESERVATION OF WILD BIRDS<sup>1</sup>

Commencement [20th November, 1915]

### PART I—PROTECTION OF BIRDS<sup>2</sup>

#### 1 Short title

This Act may be cited as the Birds Preservation Act.<sup>3</sup>

#### 2 Definition<sup>4</sup>

In this Act —

“**Minister**” means the Minister responsible for environment;<sup>5</sup>

“**protected area**” means any area comprising land, or water, or land and water, as is specified in the Second Schedule hereto;<sup>6</sup>

“**protected bird**” includes all such birds whether imported into or indigenous to the Kingdom and the eggs and progeny of any such birds as are mentioned in the First Schedule hereto;
