CUSTOMS AND EXCISE MANAGEMENT ACT ORDER 2007¹

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 45 of the Customs and Excise Management Act 2007, the Chief Commissioner, with the approval of His Majesty in Council, makes the following Order:

Commencement [21st January 2008]

- (1) That the goods specified in Schedule 1 of this Order shall be prohibited and restricted from importation into Tonga.
- (2) That the goods specified in Schedule 2 of this Order shall be prohibited and restricted from exportation from Tonga.
- (3) For the purposes of this Order, "cash" means
 - (a) the coin and paper money of the Kingdom or of a foreign country that is designated as legal tender which is used customarily and accepted as a medium exchange in the country of issue;
 - (b) monetary instruments that may be exchanged for money (such as travelers cheques, money orders, negotiable instruments in a form in which the title thereto passes on delivery;
 - (c) jewellery, precious metals and precious stones, or pearls; or
 - (d) where the context permits, cash includes cash in electronic form.²
