CABINET (RESTRICTION ON REMOVAL OF CASH FROM THE KINGDOM) ORDER

Made under Regulation 3 of the Emergency Powers (Maintenance of Public Order) Regulations 2006 by Cabinet¹

Commencement [22nd November, 2006]

1 Short title

This Order may be cited as the Cabinet (Restriction on Removal of Cash from the Kingdom) Order.

2 Interpretation

In this Order, unless the context otherwise requires —

“**Customs officer**” means any officer employed by the Customs Division of the Revenue Services Department;

“**Governor**” means the Governor of the National Reserve Bank of Tonga;

“**Minister**” means the Minister of Finance;

“**remove**” means any attempt to cross any controlled exit point, including Immigration Division and Customs Division posts, and airline entry control for persons departing on an aeroplane or other craft, whilst carrying restricted cash (or causing such cash to be removed in a suitcase or other baggage or storage that belongs to the traveller or any other person);
