FISHERIES MANAGEMENT (PROCESSING AND EXPORT) REGULATIONS

FISHERIES MANAGEMENT ACT 2002

In exercise of the powers contained in section 101 of the Fisheries Management Act 2002, the Minister makes the following Regulations —

Commencement [6th June 2008]¹

PART 1 - PRELIMINARY

1. Citation

These Regulations may be cited as the Fisheries Management (Processing and Export) Regulations.

2. Interpretation

In these Regulations —

- (a) the terms and phrases defined in the Fisheries Management Act 2002 shall be given the same meaning in these regulations, unless the context requires otherwise;
- (b) unless the context otherwise requires —

"Act" means the Fisheries Management Act 2002;
