**The Regulation of Care (Social Service Workers) (Scotland) Amendment Order 2013**

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 44(1) (b) of the Regulation of Care (Scotland) Act 2001<sup>(1)</sup> and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 44(4) of that Act they have consulted the Scottish Social Services Council and such other persons and groups as they consider appropriate.

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the Regulation of Care (Social Service Workers) (Scotland) Amendment Order 2013 and comes into force on 1st August 2013.

**Amendment to the Regulation of Care (Social Service Workers) (Scotland) Order 2005**

2. In article 1(2) of the Regulation of Care (Social Service Workers) (Scotland) Order 2005 (citation, commencement and interpretation)<sup>(2)</sup> in the definition of “residential child care worker” omit “, not being a social worker,”.
