**The A477 Trunk Road (Carew  
Roundabout to East Williamston,  
Pembrokeshire) (Temporary Speed  
Restrictions & No Overtaking)  
Order 2016**

*Made* 3 June 2016

*Coming into force* 12 June 2016

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the length of the St Clears – Pembroke Dock Trunk Road (A477) (“the trunk road”), are satisfied that traffic in a specified length of the trunk road should be restricted or prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1), (4) and (7) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

**Title, Interpretation and Commencement**

**1.** This Order comes into force on 12 June 2016 and its title is The A477 Trunk Road (Carew Roundabout to East Williamston, Pembrokeshire) (Temporary Speed Restrictions & No Overtaking) Order 2016.

**2.—(1)** In this Order:

“exempted vehicle” (“*cerbyd esempt*”) means:

(a) any vehicle being used by the emergency services; and

(b) any vehicle being used for naval, military or air force purposes and are being driven by a person for the time being subject to the orders of the member of the armed forces of the
