The Scottish Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred by article 17(1) of the Foot and Mouth Disease Order 1983<sup>(1)</sup>, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Order:

**Citation and commencement**

**1.** This Order may be cited as the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Scotland) Declaratory (Amendment) (No. 6) Order 2001 and shall come into force on 10th April 2001 at 2.00 p.m.

**Amendment of infected area**

**2.** For Schedule 1 to the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Scotland) Declaratory Order 2001<sup>(2)</sup>, there is substituted the Schedule 1 set out in the Schedule to this Order.

**Revocation**

**3.** The Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Scotland) Declaratory (Amendment) (No. 5) Order 2001<sup>(3)</sup> is revoked.
