**The A4042 Trunk Road (Llanellen
Bridge, Llanellen, Monmouthshire)
(Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles)
Order 2011**

Coming into force

2 October 2011

The Welsh Ministers, as the traffic authority for the Newport – Shrewsbury Trunk Road (A4042) (hereinafter referred to as “the trunk road”), are satisfied that traffic in a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited by reason of works proposed to be executed thereon.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984⁽¹⁾ and of all other enabling powers⁽²⁾, make this Order.

1. This Order comes into force on 2 October 2011 and its title is The A4042 Trunk Road (Llanellen Bridge, Llanellen, Monmouthshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2011.

2. —1) In this Order:

“the length of the trunk road” (“*y darn o’r gefnffordd*”) means that length of the A4042 trunk road at Llanellen Bridge, Llanellen in the County of Monmouthshire, that extends from a point 100 metres north of the centre-point of its junction with Gypsi Lane, extending in a northerly direction for 250 metres, to a point near Hardwick Interchange;

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means that period commencing at 00:01 hours on 2 October 2011 and ending when the temporary traffic signs have been removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article is a reference to the article bearing that number in this Order.
