**The A465 Trunk Road
(Eastbound Slip Roads at Llanfoist
Junction, Llanfoist,
Monmouthshire) (Temporary
Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2011**

Made 23 September 2011

Coming into force 3 October 2011

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant length of the Neath – Abergavenny Trunk Road (A465) (hereinafter referred to as “the trunk road”), are satisfied that traffic in specified lengths of the trunk road should be prohibited by reason of works proposed to be executed thereon.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers(2), make this Order.

1. This Order comes into force on the 3 October 2011 and its title is The A465 Trunk Road (Eastbound Slip Roads at Llanfoist Junction, Llanfoist, Monmouthshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2011.

2. (1) In this Order:

“exempted vehicle” (*“cerbyd esempt”*) means any vehicle being used by the emergency services or in connection with the works giving rise to this Order;

“the lengths of the trunk road” (*“y darnau o’r gefnffordd”*) means:

- i. the length of the eastbound off slip road at Llanfoist Junction that extends from its diverge with the main eastbound carriageway of the A465 trunk road to a point 60 metres south west of the A4143 Waitrose gyratory;
