The A40 Trunk Road (Penblewin,
Narberth, Pembrokeshire)
(Temporary Traffic Restrictions &
Prohibition) Order 2011

Made *31 August 2011*

Coming into force *12 September 2011*

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant length of the London - Fishguard Trunk Road (A40) (hereinafter referred to as “the trunk road”), are satisfied that traffic in a specified length of the trunk road should be restricted or prohibited by reason of works being executed thereon.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers(2), make this Order.

1. This Order comes into force on 12 September 2011 and its title is The A40 Trunk Road (Penblewin, Narberth, Pembrokeshire) (Temporary Traffic Restrictions & Prohibition) Order 2011.

2. —(1) In this Order:

“exempted vehicle” (*“cerbyd esempt”*) means any vehicle being used for the emergency services or in connection with the works giving rise to this Order;

“the length of the trunk road” (*“y darn o’r gefnffordd”*) means that length of the A40 trunk road in the County of Pembrokeshire which extends from its junction with the B4313 to Maenclochog to a point 2635 metres east of the said junction;

“works period” (*“cyfnod y gwaith”*) means the period commencing at 08:00 hours on 12 September 2011 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.
